



Transportation Policy

Spokane International Academy provides transportation to and from hubs around the Spokane area, located within areas of high demand, during regular school hours. Good conduct and compliance with transportation rules are required to maintain the bus transportation privilege. Students are expected to follow all safety rules while riding the bus. It is important to remember that any time the driver must remove his/her eyes from the road to address those children not complying with the rules, the entire bus is placed in jeopardy.

Children are expected to:

- 1.** Exhibit REACH values at all times
- 2.** Remain in their seats, feet and body facing forward
- 3.** Talk in quiet voices
- 4.** Obey the bus driver
- 5.** Speak in respectful voices
- 6.** Keep feet out of the aisles
- 7.** Refrain from eating or drinking on the bus
- 8.** Keep hands to themselves and inside the bus

If any child should choose not to follow the rules, he/she risks being referred for disciplinary action by the bus driver. The following procedures assume a typical infraction from the list above. Behavior that substantially endangers students or adults, will result in students progressing through the steps below at a quicker rate.

- 1.** 1st referral - Warning - Contact Home
- 2.** 2nd referral - 1 week bus suspension - Parent Conference
- 3.** 3rd referral - 1 month bus suspension- Parent Conference
- 4.** 4th referral - Removal of bus privilege - Parent Notification
