Athletic/Activities Code

Officials, coaches, and leaders of student activities believe that students who are selected for the privilege of membership on teams, clubs, and other school organizations should conduct themselves as responsible representatives of the school. In order to assure this conduct, the athletic department, as well as the administration at Spokane International Academy, enforces a Code of Conduct. Furthermore, members of teams and/or organizations who fail to abide by the Code of Conduct are subject to disciplinary action.

Members of teams and organizations must always serve as exemplars of high moral character and must demonstrate appropriate academic commitment, which is expected from all students. As recognized representatives of their school, members are expected to exhibit **REACH values** during the season and out of season, in uniform, and out of uniform, on campus, and off campus.

Spokane International Academy's primary goal is the **academic education** of all students. Therefore, each coach and activity leader has the obligation to encourage students to perform within reasonable academic standards. If a student has a D in one or more of his/her classes, that student will be placed on **academic probation** for two weeks. Within those two weeks, the D is expected to go up to a C or the student may not practice or compete in meets. If a student has an F, he/she is immediately **ineligible** to play. That student may not practice or compete in meets until he/she has a C in the failing class. *Students in 1st and 2nd grade do not receive letter grades, therefore eligibility is based on behavior and willingness to do work consistently.*

We strongly disapprove of students staying home on school days to rest for events that day or night. The administration reserves the right to limit participation of students in cases of non-**attendance** at school. In addition, students who miss more than 50% of school on a game day, for any reason, will be ineligible to play that day. Rule enforcement will be consistent and immediate.

Each coach and activity leader has the prerogative to establish **additional rules** pertaining to the activity supervised. These rules may include attendance at practices, dress code, and conduct of participants during practices, contests, trips, etc.

Students on academic ineligibility as well as those suspended from school by the dean's office will not be allowed to participate in activities or athletics while they are ineligible/suspended.
